We support young actors, directors, writers and producers to learn their craft; we invest in groundbreaking programmes in schools to raise aspiration among young people; and we use theatre skills to work with charities and local organisations to enable the more disadvantaged in the community to participate in what we do. We also offer 100 seats a night at £12 to the under 25s.
